Dear Provost Neely,

Following an agreement between the Faculty Senate and WOUFT to form a joint committee to examine and assess the proposed online course and instructor evaluation (see attached), the WOUFT Executive Board has voted unanimously to recommend delay of implementation of any new online course evaluation instrument until Spring Term 2010. We believe that delaying implementation until spring will allow the committee sufficient time to consider the proposed instrument and make recommendations in the interests of creating a WOU-specific course and instructor evaluation instrument that effectively meets the needs of students, faculty, and administration. As has been past practice at WOU, faculty members who wish to have their winter term courses evaluated could make arrangements with their division chairs or administrative assistants to do so.
